Discussion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinic Committee Chair, Dr. Mark Horrocks, facilitated the meeting and began with an overview on what SHIP and Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH) means. • Dr. Horrocks described the structure of the SHC three tiered system, which includes the Executive Committee, Clinic Committee, and Medical Health Neighborhood. • Cohort 1 clinics were given the opportunity to share their successes and challenges with the group. Each of the cohort 1 clinics reported lessons learned for the benefit of the new SHIP clinics. • Dr. Horrocks expressed his interest and willingness to visit clinics and present to their staff to assist with physician buy-in for PCMH transformation. He distributed handouts on huddles, PCMH information, and tips on achieving true practice transformation. • A cohort 2 clinic asked for some details on care coordination and how it functions within PCMH clinics. Cohort 1 care coordinators were participating in the meeting and were able to share information with the cohort 2 clinic staff. • New clinics were urged by cohort 1 to utilize Allison, SHIP QI Specialist. She is recognized as a valuable asset to the transformation process. She welcomes the opportunity to assist clinics in any way she is able.
