Southeastern Idaho Public Health's Goal

The goal of the Drug Overdose Prevention Program at Southeastern Idaho Public Health (SIPH) is to advance opioid prevention work through public and prescriber education, local capacity building, public safety partnerships, and addressing the social determinants of health. To help further our community partners work in preventing substance use disorders, SIPH has developed this resource guide. In this packet, you will find opioid prescribing data and local resources, including where to get free naloxone.

Statistics

In 2023, 386 deaths related to any drug overdose occurred in Idaho. Out of those, 264 were related to an opioid overdose. In addition, 3,896 emergency department visits related to any drug overdose occurred, and 1,130,006 prescriptions for opioids were issued in Idaho. Further, while substance use disorder (SUD) is a serious problem in the United States, less than 1 in 10 people with a SUD receive treatment.

MOUD Treatment

Medication for Opioid Use Disorder, or MOUD, is currently the most effective form of treatment of opioid misuse, because it uses medication along with behavioral therapies to help those with an opioid use disorder manage their addiction to live a normal life.

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Opioid Prescribing & Drug Overdose Data


Opioids include full opioid agonist, partial opioid agonist, and combination opioid agonist/antagonist pharmacological classes. This includes buprenorphine/naloxone combinations as well as codeine antitussive by prescriptions.

NALOXONE

Naloxone is a medication that temporarily reverses the effects of an opioid overdose.

Who should carry it?

- Anyone who is prescribed opioids or is around someone prescribed opioids.
- Anyone who uses illicit opioids or may be around someone who uses illicit opioids.
- Anyone who may encounter someone overdosing.

How to get it?

- Anyone can get naloxone; it does not need to be intended for your own use.
- Naloxone is an over-the-counter medication and no longer requires a prescription.
- Southeastern Idaho Public Health distributes free naloxone to community members and organizations.
- Idaho Department of Health and Welfare and Kootenai County Fire & Rescue provides free naloxone to organizations. Use the QR code or link below to access the naloxone request form.

Important Notes

- Naloxone is only effective on overdoses involving opioids.
- Individuals overdosing should receive medical services immediately.
- The effects of naloxone only last 30-60 minutes and in some cases with highly potent fentanyl only 20 minutes.
- Naloxone should be stored at room temperature.
