New Day Products funding request for vehicle for transport of clients: Shantal reported to the board that the decision of the review committee was to deny this grant due to a conflict of interest this grant was denied. Discussion ensued on this topic. Scholarship discussion: Stace shared that the in-person and /or virtual trainings are increasing this time of the year.
