As introduction to this training we learned about the different types of opioids and opiates, how the work within the body along with the side effects and Idaho opioid use stats from 2021 were given. The training transitioned into the overdose prevention strategies, recognition of an overdose, securing medications & unused medication disposal, harm reduction, how to recognize an overdose and administer naloxone, and harm reduction and the Good Samaritan Law. There was also a brief discussion on Idaho House Bill 350 within the legislation that will effect the funding of naloxone at this time.
