Stewards of Recovery main office is in Idaho Falls and was started in 2015. It is an adult residential treatment program, with four facilities in Blackfoot serving around seventy people-both men and women. There are also other outpatient treatment programs including a state funded social detox offered as well. The in-patient program is sixty to ninety-day program. For this region they are working on updating a newly purchased building to house a residential treatment program for women with children.
