

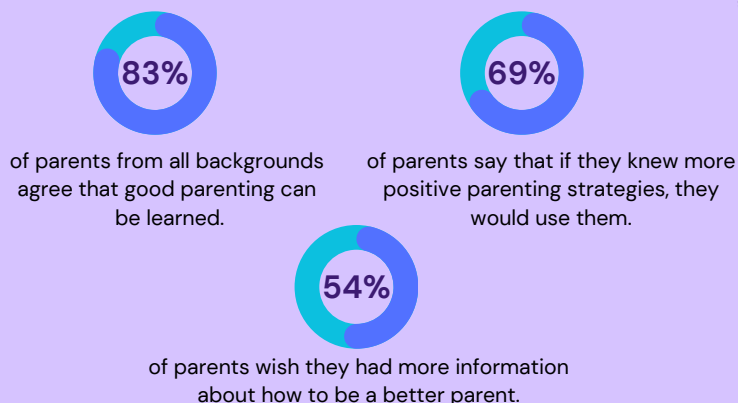
Empowering Parenthood: SIPH's Parents as Teachers Program

approximately **1 in 6** children in the United States, or 17%, has at least one developmental delay.

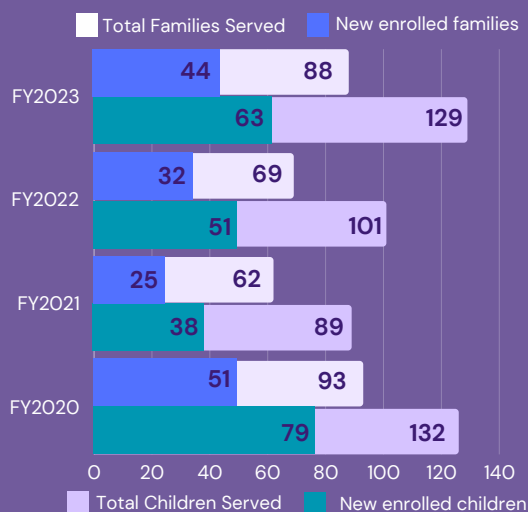

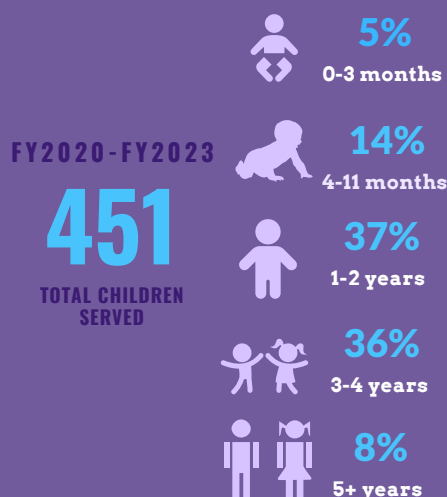
approximately **10-20%** of mothers are estimated to experience Postpartum depression, making it a significant public health concern

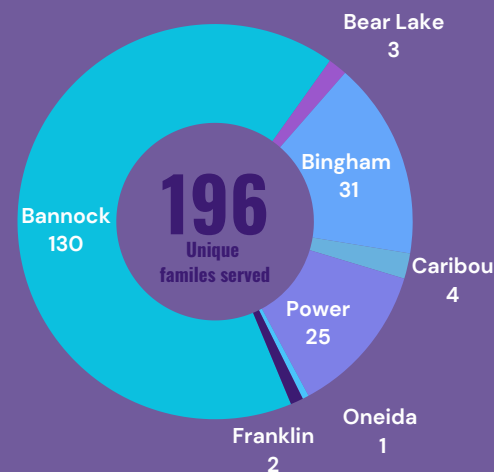
Family and Child Services: A Graphical Overview



Age Demographics of Total Children Served

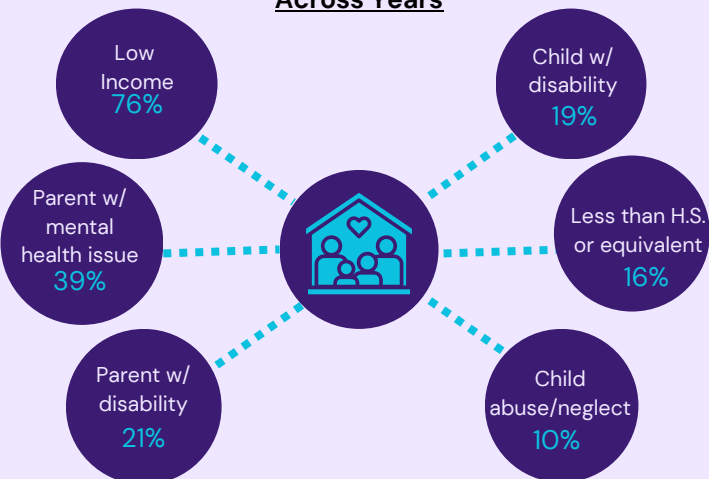


County-wide Analysis: Families Served

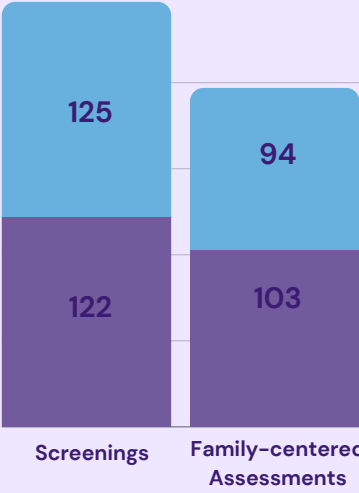

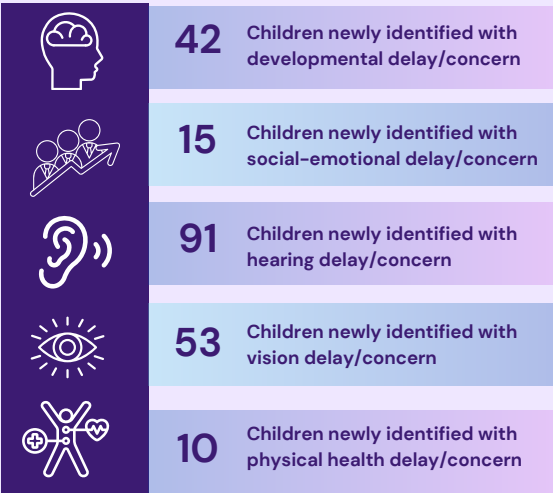

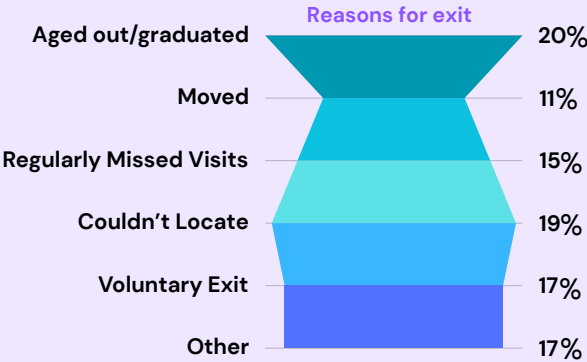

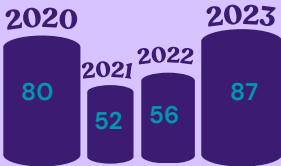
Home Visiting Program Impact Evaluation: Assessing Overall Influence

Domain	Percentage
Improvement in ability to reach goals for oneself and one's family	100
Stress reduction	84.6
Improvement in parenting skills	80.8

Program Participation and Improvement Indicators: Assessing Progress

Domain	Percentage
Having someone to talk to when worried about one's children	80
Having confidence in ability to parent and take care of one's children	76.2
Knowing who to contact in the community when in need of help	76.2
