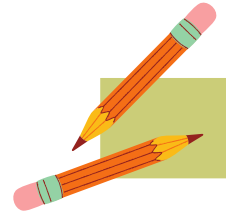




SIPH SCHOOL SERVICES



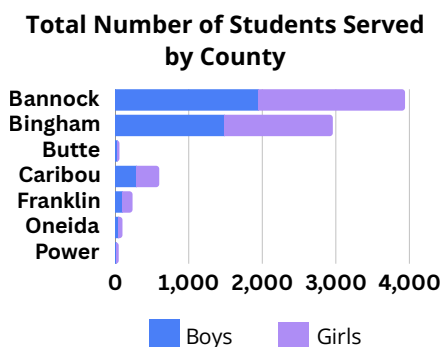

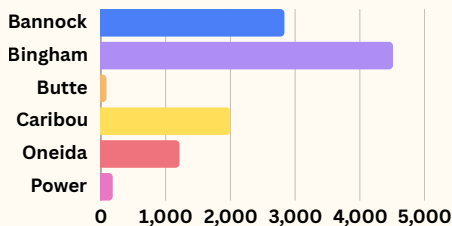

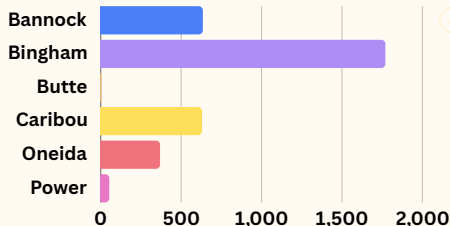

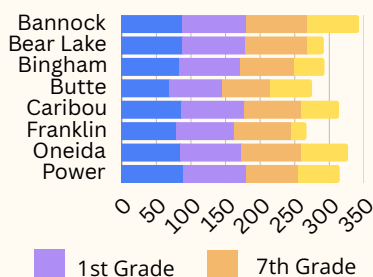

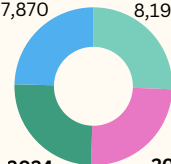
