On April 3rd and 4th, at the Shoshone-Bannock Hotel & Event Center, the Southeastern Idaho Healthcare Coalition, Eastern Idaho Healthcare Coalition, and South Central Healthcare Preparedness Coalition will be hosting the Regional Readiness Rendezvous for area healthcare and emergency response personnel.
