## **COVID-19 VACCINE FACTS**



#### WHAT IS A COVID-19 VACCINE?

It is a shot with medicine. It helps keep you from getting sick with COVID-19.



#### WHICH COVID-19 VACCINE IS THE BEST?

Any of the shots help keep you from getting sick with COVID-19. Some vaccines need two shots to work and some only need one shot.

- Moderna = two shots (age 18 or older)
- Pfizer = two shots (age 16 or older)



#### DO I HAVE TO GET THE VACCINE?

No, it is your choice. Talk to someone you trust, like a family member, friend, or doctor if you have questions.



### **HOW MUCH DOES THE VACCINE COST?**

Nothing. The vaccine is free. Bring your insurance card if you have insurance.



### WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS?

You have the right to get a COVID-19 vaccine if you want one.



#### **HOW DO I GET THE VACCINE?**

You need to make an appointment. Call your doctor or go to www.siphidaho.org/coronavirus.php to see where you can schedule your vaccine.

# WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT AT THE VACCINE APPOINTMENT?

Wear a mask to your appointment. You will get a card that shows you got your COVID-19 vaccine. Keep that card in a safe place. Bring the card to your second appointment. You will have to wait for 15 – 30 minutes after your shot to make sure you are okay.



#### WILL I GET SICK FROM THE VACCINE?

Some people feel sick and some do not. If you feel bad, it is often only for a day or two.

- You may have a sore arm
- You may feel tired
- You may have a headache, fever or feel cold
- You may feel sick to your stomach



# DO I STILL NEED TO WEAR A MASK AFTER MY VACCINE?

Yes, you should keep taking precautions in public places like wearing a mask, staying 6 feet apart from others, and avoiding crowds and poorly ventilated spaces until we know more.
