Southeastern Idaho Public Health’s Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of November 30 – December 6, 2021, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 238 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 27,132. Out of the 27,132 cases, 26,464 have recovered from COVID-19. There were also 8 confirmed deaths, which brings the total to 429 deaths, due to COVID-19. Out of respect to these individuals’ families, no additional details will be released.
