Southeastern Idaho Public Health’s Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of November 16 – November 22, 2021, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 347 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 26,694. Out of the 26,694 cases, 25,952 have recovered from COVID-19. There were also 5 confirmed deaths, which brings the total to 410 deaths, due to COVID-19. Out of respect to these individuals’ families, no additional details will be released.
