## Southeastern Idaho Public Health’s Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of November 23 – November 29, 2021, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 193 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 26,896. Out of the 26,896 cases, 26,254 have recovered from COVID-19. There were also 11 confirmed deaths, which brings the total to 421 deaths, due to COVID-19. Out of respect to these individuals’ families, no additional details will be released.
