Southeastern Idaho Public Health’s Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of November 2 -November 8, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 466 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 26,072. Out of the 26,072 cases, 25,107 have recovered from COVID-19.

There were also nine confirmed deaths, which brings the total to 399 deaths due to COVID-19. Out of respect to these individuals’ families, no additional details will be released.
