Southeastern Idaho Public Health’s Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of October 19 – October 25, 2021, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 640 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 24,992. Out of the 24,992 cases, 23,953 have recovered from COVID-19. There were also 17 confirmed deaths, which brings the total to 367 deaths, due to COVID-19. Out of respect to these individuals’ families, no additional details will be released.
