Southeastern Idaho Public Health’s Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of September 28-October 4, 2021, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 793 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 22,725. Out of the 22,725 cases, 21,501 have recovered from COVID-19. There were also 23 confirmed deaths, which brings the total to 311 deaths, due to COVID-19. Out of respect to these individuals’ families, no additional details will be released.
