## Southeastern Idaho Public Health’s Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of July 26 – August 1, 2022, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 236 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 40,550. Out of the 40,550 cases, 39,712 have recovered from COVID-19. There are 5 confirmed deaths, which brings the total to 533 deaths, due to COVID-19. Out of respect to these individuals’ families, no additional details will be released.
